



Mt. Olympus Berry Farm 2020 CSA

What is a CSA? Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a system whereby members purchase a "share" of fruits and vegetables at the beginning of the season, at a time when farmers incur the highest costs. This provides farmers with much needed capital to get started each season and together farmers and members share in both the risks and bounty of the season. Each week the members receive their share of the harvest.

Membership contract

For 2020 we will offer a full season share with a fall add on option. Full Season: (16 weeks) from May 15 to Aug 28. Fall add on: (4 weeks) from Oct 2 to October 23 (Open to farm & McLean pick up only). There will be a full weekly share or a smaller half share. You can opt to an egg share add on. You can also opt to add a donation to a local family in need: \$25 provides one week full share, \$15 one week half share or choose your own amount.

Added benefits of CSA purchase: Receive additional 10% off bulk specials offered on farm for the duration of the special. (Does not have to be on pick up day.) These discounts may not be combined with other offers.

I understand that by signing this agreement I am committing myself to picking up my allotted share. The main pick up day will be on Friday of each distribution week. Fairfax Co. Herndon & McLean market shareholders will need to pick up at designated drop location each week. Any share not picked up will be donated.

If you are going on vacation or unable to pick up your share, please make arrangements at least a week in advance. In the event that I am unable to pick up my share, I allow _____ to obtain the share on my behalf or donated to a local family.

If share is not picked during the designated pick up time (and the farm is not notified of a delay), the produce will be donated to a local family in need. Refunds or replacements will not be offered for missed pick-ups. Exceptions may be considered on a case by case basis.

I understand that farming is a seasonal and unpredictable undertaking. Natural disasters such as drought, windstorms, too much rain and other "acts of God" may impact what products are available, how much of a particular product is available and the quality of the product. I understand that these conditions could occur and affect the product that I receive or even result in an entire crop failure. I agree to share in the fluctuations and variations inherent in farming and understand that my items will be grown and harvested with sound, sustainable farming practices.

Products not grown by our farm may be purchased from other local farmers who share in our farming practices. These partnerships allow us to offer a wider variety of items in our weekly boxes, reduce the risk to our members and support other local farmers.

I understand that if my membership is terminated before the end date of this agreement, I will not receive a full refund. I may receive a partial refund to be determined by the farm. I may sell or transfer my share to another party. They will be required to register and sign a separate membership agreement. I have read and understand the information provided and agree to the terms of this agreement.
